

# FamVin Pilgrimage to Philippines



34 participants from different Vincentian parishes and

organizations in Taiwan went to the Philippines last March 10-18, 2017 to participate in Taiwan Vincentian Family Pilgrimage and Social Service Exposure Program. Organized by Fr. Ferdinand Labitag and supported by Fr. Henricus Susilo and Fr. Thomas Gao, the group went to Vincentian churches,

seminary, and social services in Metro Manila. They went to

the program sites at the garbage dumpsite in Payatas, the housing project in Bagong Silangan and Hospicio de San Jose to see how the Vincentians in the Philippines do their social services. They also went to some historical churches and other significant pilgrimage sites to experience the Filipino way of expressing faith.

The group came back enriched with experiences from their trip as they realized that there are more things that need to done for others in order to make their own faith truly alive.

The program organizes exposures to places of Vincentian Family in different countries with an aim of forming members of FamVin groups in Taiwan to have deeper faith through service.

Fr. Jiang was specially remembered during a Mass on March 25, 2017 at St. Therese Church in New York where he used to serve. Chinese priests and parishioners attended the memorial Mass. May his soul rest upon You, O Lord!

## China confreres organized sexual harassment workshop

Confreres in China organized a workshop on sexual harassment and management of accusations on April 5-6, 2017. The event, a first for a religious community in China, dealt with the definition of sexual harassment and challenges faced by women when raising complaints in priest-run organizations. The sessions were greatly enhanced by the presence of priests from two seminaries and two local dioceses.



Dr. Wang from Kaohsiung gave the talks and guided them through legal issues as what Taiwan have developed and encountered. This seminar is an eye-opener for confreres who only have heard of the enormous problems that the Catholic Church is facing on this issue.
