Visit to Australia of Fr. Carl Pieber CM, Sub-Director General of the AMM

We were delighted to have Fr Carl Pieber CM, the Sub-Director General of the AMM, visit the AMM here in Australia during September. Fr Carl had been invited by the AMM in Thailand to visit Thailand and attend a National gathering there in September. Fr. Carl decided that he would also visit the AMM in the Philippines and also here in Australia. He came into Sydney from Manilla on Friday August 30th, and was with us from that time until he left for Thailand on Monday September 10th.

During that time he concelebrated with our National Director, Fr Kevin Canty CM, the Novena Mass at St Anthony's Church, Marsfield, on Saturday September 1st, and joined our members at the Morning Tea held in the parish hall following the Mass.

On the following day, Sunday September 2nd, he again concelebrated with Fr Kevin at the 10.00 am parish Eucharist in St Vincent's Church, Ashfield, and joined with parishioners in the parish hall for morning tea following the Eucharist.

On the following Saturday, September 8th, he travelled with Fr Kevin to the Good Shepherd Church at Plumpton in the Parramatta diocese, where he was the principal celebrant, Fr Kevin concelebrating with him at the Eucharist for the feast of the Birthday of Mary, the Mother of God. After the Mass, both priests joined with AMM members and visitors for morning tea. During his time with us, Fr. Carl gave two wonderful talks on Mary, both of which are available on our website amm.org.au.

On Sunday, September 9th, Fr Carl was present at our Core Group meeting at Marsfield, where he challenged us regarding a possible National Assembly and the setting up of a National Executive. Later, having left us, he sent a report on the AMM in Australia. This report is printed here in this bulletin.


